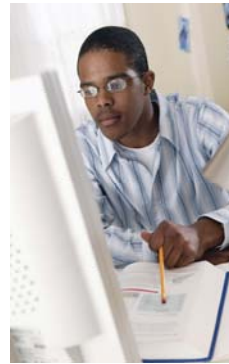

## Atlanta Tech granted \$1.2 million for Black Male Initiative

Atlanta Technical College is the proud recipient of a \$1.2 million grant awarded by the US Department of Education Office of Post-secondary Education to be dispersed over the next two years. This grant is a part of the Predominantly Black Institutions (PBI) program whose mission is to strengthen predominantly Black institutions in carrying out programs in various educational areas including improving educational outcomes of African-American males.



On our campus, the grant will facilitate workshops, think-tanks, group discussions, and other specifically designed activities that will enhance cultural awareness, decision-making skills, financial IQ, time management, general coping and social skills. The expected outcome is increased retention and overall improvement of academic performance of all males involved in the program.

The awards were highly competitive, with Atlanta Tech being among only 25 colleges to receive grant funding. **CONGRATULATIONS ATC!**

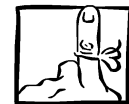
